Allocation of Accommodation

Members are asked to note that accommodation is allocated by the Holiday Camp staff. It is therefore not possible to make last minute changes. Please also note that your request for a double or twin beds will be filled subject to availability. If you cannot under any circumstances sleep in a double bed please let us know, as early as possible. We will speak to the booking Staff to secure your twin bed. Due to the location of double & twin rooms at the Mill Rythe staff cannot guarantee that Branch members will be accommodated in adjacent rooms.

Table Allocation

Members are asked to state which Branch or who they would like to sit with. We will try to seat you with those you have elected, but reserve the right to place people where we wish for reasons of Health and Safety, therefore it may not be possible to seat all members on their preferred table.
